**Re: Revised Scheduling Agreement for OHCA Docket No. 15-32016-486 and Attorney General Docket No. 15-486-01**

Dear Mr. Spees and Mr. McConville:

This letter revises the schedule set forth in Connecticut General Statutes § 19a-486b(a) in connection with the hospital conversion dockets OHCA Docket No. 15-32016-486 and Attorney General Docket No. 15-486-01 currently pending in the Department of Public Health, Office of Health Care Access (“OHCA”) and the Office of the Attorney General (the “OAG”). The Applicants for both these dockets are Eastern Connecticut Health Network, Inc. (“ECHN”) and Prospect Medical Holdings, Inc. (“PMH”).

Due to the press of business at OHCA and the increased responsibilities of its review, OHCA has requested an extension of the 120-day review period as set forth below. The OAG, although not in need of an extension, agrees that the 120-day review period should be extended for both dockets so that they stay on parallel tracks.

Therefore, pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 19a-486b(a) and after discussion, the parties have agreed to the following schedule for completion of the ECHN and PMH hospital conversion review. Specifically, the parties agree to extend the 120-day review period set forth in § 19a-486b(a) until **June 10, 2016**. Our offices will make every effort to proceed in a manner

that will permit our offices to complete its review by June 10, 2016. If it becomes apparent due to unforeseen circumstances that we cannot complete the ECHN/PMH review by the date established above, all parties will convene at the earliest opportunity to agree upon a revised final decision completion date.




