Dear Mr. Hawes and Mr. Lazarus:

On August 18, 2014, Greater Waterbury Health Network, Inc. ("GWHN") and Vanguard Health Systems, Inc. ("Vanguard") (collectively, the "Applicants") filed responses to Attorney General's First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production and OHCA's Supplemental Questions and Request for Information and Materials, both dated July 28, 2014. Subsequent to that filing, Applicants determined that it was necessary to make a modification to the initial ownership structure of VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC. While Applicants' August 18, 2014, filing indicated that an 80-20 joint venture between Vanguard and Yale-New Haven Health Services Corporation ("YNHH") would be the acquirer of the 80% interest in VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC not owned by GWHN, the Applicants now have decided that a wholly owned affiliate of Vanguard, VHS of Connecticut, LLC, will acquire the 80% interest in question. It is, however, the intention of VHS of Connecticut, LLC to transfer this 80% ownership interest post-closing to an 80-20 joint venture between a Vanguard affiliate and YNHH. Thus, post-closing, the ownership structure of VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC would be identical to that described in Applicants' response to OHCA supplemental question number 6a.

This change in the initial ownership structure will have no impact on the CON hearing process or on the scope of review of this transaction by the Office of the Attorney General or the Office of Health Care Access. In addition, it will not impact the management or operations of VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC. In fact, as you will see from the attachments, the only changes to Applicants' August 18, 2014, filing are to question 6 of OHCA's supplemental questions and to the organizational chart in question 19 of the Attorney General's Interrogatorics.



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To formalize the above-described change, Applicants are submitting herewith revisions to Applicants' responses to Attorney General's First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production and their responses to OHCA's Supplemental Questions and Request for Information and Materials. Also enclosed is an affidavit signed by Mr. Pilgrim as to the one change to Applicants' responses to the Attorney General's interrogatories.

- 6. In follow-up to Applicants' response to Question 11 in Applicants' June 27, 2014 submission, please provide the following:
 - a. A detailed explanation of the proposed relationship that VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC would have to the Regional Provider Organization ("RPO") described in the response to Question 11 and the impact the RPO would have on VIIS Waterbury Health System, LLC's operations.

A wholly owned subsidiary of Vanguard Health Systems, Inc., VHS of Connecticut, LLC, will acquire an 80% interest in VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC with the other 20% being acquired by Greater Waterbury Health Network, Inc. It is, however, the intention, however, of VHS of Connecticut, LLC to transfer its ownership interest in VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC post-closing to an 80-20 joint venture between a Vanguard affiliate and Yale-New Haven Health Services Corporation ("YNHH"). While VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC would not be a member of the RPO at closing, it would be a member of the RPO upon the transfer of VHS of Connecticut, LLC's ownership interest to the 80-20 joint venture between a Vanguard affiliate and YNHH. The day-to-day operations of the RPO subsidiaries will be managed by an affiliate of Vanguard and, therefore, the RPO will have no management responsibilities or authority and no impact on the operations of VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC.

b. A detailed explanation of the proposed relationship that VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC would have to the Regional Risk Organization ("RRO") described in the response to Question 11 and the impact the RRO would have on VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC's operations.

It is anticipated that once ownership of VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC is transferred from VHS of Connecticut, LLC to the 80-20 Tenet-YNHH joint venture, that VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC will participate in the Regional Risk Organization ("RRO") described in response to Question #11 of Applicants' June 27, 2014, submission and, as a result, will benefit from the clinical integration required by the RRO.

c. A detailed explanation of the proposed relationship that VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC would have to the Regional Physician Network Organization ("RPNO") described in the response to Question 11 and the impact the RPNO would have on VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC's operations.

It is anticipated that physicians employed by VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC and its affiliated medical foundation will participate in the Regional Physician Network Organization ("RPNO") described in response to Question #11 of Applicants' June 27, 2014, submission and that VHS Waterbury Health System, LLC will benefit from clinical integration initiatives made by the RPNO.


