The results of this check indicate that a number of trees which were considered dead in 1942 have sprouted up again. The occurrence of Blight was moderate to severe on 280 trees or 34% of those remaining alive. Frost damage seemed to be almost as severe as the blight damage.

The entire plantation has come into a very dense stand of Virginia Pine 20 to 30 feet tall. The young chestnut trees are being very severely overtopped so the study on this plot is about completed.
