Mr. Taylor's house; both should apparently date back to around 1917. 2 different families have previously o owned the far: (1) Worster and (2) Lagsden. Of these, it seems that the Worster family are most probably the one who received the trees. Varous laborers who have worked for Mr. Taylor and who were living around Fairhop at time the trees were received, state that they are positive these trees came from Washington. It is possible that your records may not show the point of delivery as Fairhope, but rather Daphne, Loxley, or even Robersdale, all in Alabama.
