Prattville, Ala.; Floyd Smith (notes for 1939 lot only, planted at new site)

Mr. Smith moved late in 1938, for notes on trees planted at his former place see the records of Edd Rogers. Below are directions for reaching the present place.

Directions:

Follow black top to court house, at court house jog left *** across RR tracks and then follow black top along the RR tracks for 0.3 m; at next RR crossing continue straight ahead across tracks onto gravel road, follow this road for 0.9 m until reaching a large two story house on left.

Trees are planted in an orchard, soil is a deep sandy loam, nearly level, good growth of plumbs on same site. All the chestnuts are making good growth this year. Average about 12 inches growth. Several trees had one burr each. Cultivated but not fertalized.

Mr. Smith was not home and will be away until the 18th. Mrs Smith did not know where the notes for the planting were. I am sending him a carbon of map of orchard with request to indicate varieties on it.
