"... Along the Sound at Stamford there was very little frost injury as the temperature here was about 45° F in most places. The grounds of the Bartlett Tree Research Laboratories are located about eight miles north of the Sound with an elevation of over 400 feet. There is frequently a spread of 10° between conditions here and on the Sound.
