G.E.Fisher sent in samples of nuts from six medium size and one large tree from this farm. These trees about 2 years older than the Glenn E. Fisher trees. Trees planted along an old fence row on a gradually western slope, in top soil that is about 12" deep under which is limestone clay. The field to the south is cultivated and on the north side is a sod lane. Trees look healthy but do not seem to bear well.
