1936 and 1937 lots are planted scattered thru woods, can be found only in active growing season. Mr. Kilgore stated that he counted the trees late this summer and found 10 of the 1936 trees alive and 4-5 of the 1937 trees living. He stated that some insect defoliates the trees just after they leaf out each spring. (I wonder if this is the same thing that gets Mr. Hatchers mollisimas, the same thing that gets the pecans)

All of the 1938 trees are alive. He has them lined out and plans to set them out this fall.
