Colossal (hybrid) is very productive and produces the largest nuts of any chestnut that I have seen growing in Tennessee, but the quality of the raw nut is not equal to Hobson. It refuses to grow on Chinese stock but thrives on Japanese. It is pollen sterile. I have several newer varieties under observation, and although they are growing vigorously I have not had time to form an opinion on them."
