From letter of T. E. Spyder to Dr. Hopkins, Bureau of Entomology, August 20. 1912.

"..plantation of about 300 chestnut trees planted 35 years ago. the trees are about 30 feet in height and range from about 6 to 14 inches D.B.H. The plantation is located at Spiceland, Ind. about 30 miles east of Indianapolis on the Terre Haute, Indianapolis and Eastern Traction Co. R.R. and belongs to A. R. Hodson. According to the Superintendent who looks after the plantation only "several" trees have diedand those within the last 2 years. Leptura nitens medium sized to apparently full gorwn larvae are common in the living bark at the bases of many of the trees. Apparently, the chestnut bark disease is not present."
