Rainier, Oregon Mr. George G. Van Natta Route 1, Box 429-A

K/ 12/6/54 European chestnut (identified as the "Delena Tree by Mr. Van Natta) "grows in comparative shade. It has three trunks, one of them being from ground level. It is about 250 feet above sea level. The land looks rocky, poor and sour, but I am not certain whether occupants fertilize it or not. Douglas firs shade this tree somewhat. I believe two or the trunks are 5" in diameter breast high and thatthey are about 30" high but I will measure and try to estimate more accurately. It apparently is not a heavy producer, but I dug up 6 or 8 youngsters from underneath it, all of which seem to be alive."
