Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2017 Regular Session on July 6:

HB 7214 PA 17-102	AN ACT CONCERNING HARASSMENT OF A GUIDE OR ASSISTANCE DOG OR THE HANDLER OF SUCH DOG. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 7230 PA 17-103	AN ACT CONCERNING THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE'S ELECTRONIC BUSINESS PORTAL. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 7243 PA 17-104	AN ACT CONCERNING SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT LIENS. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 7263 PA 17-105	AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS AND TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE TAX AND RELATED STATUTES, AND CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS FROM THE PROPERTY TAX. This bill has various effective dates. Refer to the text here.
HB 7284 PA 17-106	AN ACT CONCERNING STATE IDENTIFICATION FOR INMATES UPON REENTRY. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 7296 PA 17-107	AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE FUNDING OF UNFUNDED ACCRUED MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM LIABILITIES BY MUNICIPALITIES. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
HB 5077 PA 17-109	AN ACT CONCERNING THE RETURN OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS TO PHARMACIES. This bill shall take effect from passage.
HB 5764 PA 17-112	AN ACT CONCERNING THE LICENSING OF BARBERS AND HAIRDRESSERS. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.

HB 6266 PA 17-116	AN ACT CONCERNING BOXING EVENTS AND MIXED MARTIAL ARTS MATCHES. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 6356 PA 17-117	AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC NOTICE OF TREE REMOVAL ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTY. This bill shall take effect from passage.
HB 6668 PA 17-118	AN ACT CONCERNING PREGNANT WOMEN IN THE WORKPLACE. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
SB 129 PA 17-150	AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TAKING OF MUSHROOMS AT STATE PARKS AND ON OTHER STATE PROPERTY. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
SB 548 PA 17-152	AN ACT CONCERNING HAIRDRESSERS AND COSMETICIANS. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
SB 546 PA 17-154	AN ACT CONCERNING PARTICIPATING PROVIDER DIRECTORIES AND PROVIDERS ACCEPTING NEW PATIENTS ON AN OUTPATIENT SERVICES BASIS. This bill shall take effect January 1, 2018.
SB 922 PA 17-155	AN ACT CONCERNING TEMPORARY HEALTH CARE STRUCTURES. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 5116 PA 17-156	AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT DATA. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 5140 PA 17-157	AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENTS TO HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES. This bill shall take effect January 1, 2018.
HB 7253 PA 17-173	AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES. This bill has various effective dates. Refer to the text here.
HB 7251 PA 17-215	AN ACT CONCERNING REFORM DISTRICT TURNAROUND PLANS. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
