PROPOSED FINAL DECISION ON REMAND

Based on the June 6, 2000 remand by the Commissioner of Environmental

Protection regarding the above matter, the Connecticut Department of Transportation (the

applicant), pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §22a-3a-6(1)(3)(A)(i),

submitted an Agreed Draft Decision (Agreement) on October 5, 2001, to which it was the

only signatory. The DEP Inland Water Resources Division supports issuance of the

permit. Some of the intervenors do not concur with all the findings and conclusion

contained in this Agreement, and while they have not signed it, they do not object to

permit issuance.

Several draft side agreements between the applicant and the intervenors are

contained in this Agreement. These agreements are outside the scope of this proceeding

and their finality will not affect permit issuance.

After a review of this Agreement and the entire record of this proceeding,

including the remanded proceeding, I find by a preponderance of the substantial evidence

that this Agreement satisfactorily addresses all the applicable inland wetlands and

watercourses statutes applicable to permit issuance, as well as all the concerns raised in

the remand.

I therefore adopt all the proposed findings, conclusions and recommendations

contained in this Agreement, which is appended to this Proposed Final Decision on

Remand with its attached cover letter, and recommend that Application No. IW-96-131

be approved and the permit issued henceforth.
