Dear Ms. Gobin:

On June 15, 2015, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection. The SIP revision was submitted to meet the Clean Air Act §110(a)(2)(D)(i)(I) infrastructure requirements for the 2008 ozone standard. This SIP is also referred to as the "transport" SIP and/or the "good neighbor" SIP. The Clean Air Act requires states to address emissions that significantly contribute to nonattainment or maintenance of the ozone standard in downwind states.

EPA finds that Connecticut's SIP revision is administratively and technically complete, i.e., it meets the completeness criteria outlined in 40 CFR Part 51 Appendix V.
