The Commissioner of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) may modify any license at the request of the licensee in accordance with Section 22a-3a-5(d) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA), and any other applicable law. Any modification at the request of the licensee shall comply with the requirements of RCSA Section 22a-3a-5(a).

As requested and supported in your letter dated October 5, 2012, the DEEP Bureau of Air Management Registrations for the above mentioned equipment are hereby modified unless within 30 days of issuance of this notice a request for hearing is filed. Such request shall conform with the provisions of RCSA Subsection 22a-3a-6(i). These registrations have been modified by removing the option to burn No. 6 fuel oil. The three boilers are only allowed to burn natural gas. The DEEP will update its emissions inventory to reflect this modification.

This letter in no way grants immunity from legal action resulting from the failure of this source to remain in compliance with existing air pollution regulations, nor does it provide an exemption from compliance with future Federal, State or local laws.

Request for Modification

Dear Mr. Pirolli,

The purpose for this letter is to request the Department to revise the referenced boiler registrations. The three boilers, located in Building 1 on the Windsor Locks Campus, are dual fuel design and were capable of firing either No. 6 fuel oil or natural gas. The boilers currently are subject to NO_x Trading Order 8291, Modification 1. The trading order was necessary because NO_x emissions when firing No. 6 fuel oil exceeded the applicable limit. No. 6 fuel oil firing ceased as of December 4, 2008. The No. 6 fuel oil storage tanks have been drained and cleaned, tank heaters removed, and the supply pumps locked out.

NO_x emissions from all three boilers comply with the applicable limit when firing natural gas. Since the boilers will fire only natural gas, the trading order will no longer be required. However, in order for the trading order to be rescinded, the registrations have to be revised to eliminate No. 6 fuel oil and indicate natural gas as the only allowable fuel.
