#### **GPLPE 2006**

- Expires February 24, 2011
- Current approval of registration valid until whichever comes first:
  - new approval of registration is issued
  - February 24, 2011

#### **GPLPE 2010**

- Issued November 19, 2010
- Documents on the DEP notification webpage:
  - Notice of Issuance
  - GPLPE 2010
  - GPLPE with tracked changes from TD
  - Comments received during public comment period
  - Response to comments document
- Documents on the DEP application webpage:
  - GPLPE 2010
  - Registration form
  - Registration form instructions
- Notification mailed to current permittees

#### GPLPE 2010 – What is New

- Inclusion of GHG emissions
  - Definitions
    - CO2e
    - GHG/HFC/PFC
  - 100,000 TPY GHG on a CO2e basis limit
  - Inclusion of GHG emission factors references
- Log of actual emissions created annually March 1
- Keep copy of registration form submitted on site

# GPLPE 2010 – What is Changed

- Registration
  - No transmittal form with submission
  - Reduced registration fee to \$2,760
  - Streamlined process if no changes
  - Calculations based on most recently available data
  - Clarified notification of changes at the source to only registration process
- Record Keeping
  - Flexibility in structure EU, GEU, logical groupings
  - Increased record creation time line to 45 days

## GPLPE 2010 – What is Changed


- Reporting
  - Increased threshold to 80% for *Annual Emissions* Summary
  - Annual check of *Annual Emissions Summary* applicability
  - Streamlined *Annual Emissions Summary* content
  - Reporting date consistent with other programs March 1

## Re-registration Time Line

- Requesting January 24, 2011
- Requesting notification by February 24, 2011 if not reregistering
- Re-registrations on 2006 forms
  - Held sources have been notified to re-submit on new forms
  - Returned by CPPU

- Electronic reporting for:
  - Annual Compliance Certifications;
  - Annual Emission Summaries;
  - Exceedance Notifications.



- Anticipated to be fully functional for reports due in calendar year 2012;
