All submissions shall be provided through the web-based interface.

- Please review your editor and submitter authorizations provide updated authorizations for EMIT users;

- We have installed, tested approximately 40 prioritized technical changes in EMIT in support of the pending reporting season. Michael will comment on these shortly.

- We are setting a firm date of closing the 2011 reporting season at the March 1, 2012.

- We provide the following guidance for reporting Criteria and Section 112 pollutants:


Guidance For Reporting Emissions

- CEMs/PEMs monitoring systems that are required by statute, regulation, or Permit or Order condition, emission data generated by these systems shall serve as the basis for emissions reported in EMIT;
- reference method emission testing that has been deemed by the DEEP to be representative of current and normal operating conditions;

Guidance For Reporting Emissions

- An approved facility-specific emission factor or by Material or Mass Balance, if supporting documentation is submitted;
- EPA-published emission factors, where available; some of these will be provided automatically in EMIT from the Web Fire upload;

Emissions factors from other industry and trade groups based on sound science. These should be discussed with Technical Services.
