Reducing Regulatory Burdens

Amendment of RCSA Sections:

- 22a-174-1 & -3a revise to include significant impact levels, significant emissions rates and increments for fine particulate matter, or PM_{2.5}
- 22a-174-26 delete references to RCSA §22a-174-17 & -100
- 22a-174-30 exempt certain vehicle fleets from Stage II vapor controls
- **22a-174-36b** provide national compliance options for vehicle manufacturers within the low emission vehicle program

Repeal of RCSA Sections

- **22a-174-17** control of open burning
- 22a-174-43 portable fuel container spillage control
- 22a-174-100 permits for construction of indirect sources
