Proposed GPLPE

- Emissions Limits: Limits emission to less than 50% of major source thresholds.
- Monitoring, Record Keeping and Reporting Requirements: Clarified requirements to address deficiencies presented by EPA including:
 - Per EPA input, reinforcing the fact that for each subject emission unit located at the facility, the Permittee shall comply with all the monitoring and emissions testing requirements applicable to that emission unit;
 - Per EPA input, requiring that compliance with the emission limits of the modified GPLPE shall be based solely on the hierarchy of data collection specified in the permit and not allow for “off-permit”, custom defined emissions estimation techniques;
 - Requiring Permittees to keep records of actual operating hours on a monthly basis;



Proposed GPLPE con't.

- Requiring all Permittees to make and keep records of monthly emissions and records of aggregate emissions for each period of 12 consecutive months; and
- Requiring all Permittees to submit an Annual Emissions Summary by March 1st of each year, based on emissions occurring from January 1st to December 31st of the previous year.
- Other Changes: Updated boiler plate language to be consistent with recent Department general permit template.



GPLPE Form

- No changes in content.
- Submit all information including calculations.
- Will be sent out to SIPRAC for review.



GPLPE Issuance Timeline

Current GPLPE expires November 19, 2015

213 GPLPE Permittees

√ Send Draft to SIPRAC

- SIPRAC Presentation: August 13
- 30 Day Public Notice: by August 15
- Issue Permit: by September 24

Permittees will have eight weeks to re-register.
