

Regulations Modernization Project: Some statutory changes (2012-2016)

- Uniform Administrative Procedures Act
 - Title 4, Chapter 54
 - Regulation-making: C.G.S. § § 4-166 to 4-177
 - Sec. 4-173b. Establishment of eRegulations System and certification by Secretary of the State as the official compilation. The Secretary certified the system as official on July 1, 2017.
- Uniform Electronic Legal Material Act
 - Title 1, Chapter 15b, C.G.S. § § 1-330 et al.
 - eRegs is complaint with UELMA

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

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

About Proposed Regulations: State agencies propose regulations in order to make changes to the *Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies*-Connecticut's version of a state administrative code.

In order to become law, proposed regulations must complete an adoption process that includes approval by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the Connecticut General Assembly and posting to the eRegulations System. <u>Learn more about the Regulation-Making Process in Connecticut.</u>





 - An effective date is helpful if you need us to look something up.
- State Library has copies of the *Connecticut Law Journal* and most of the supplements to the printed *Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies*.
