This map is an initial draft listing possible locations to use in the preliminary CT NERR screening process. At this time, these are not exhaustive, are not binding in any way, and are relatively loosely represented in terms of extent and boundaries. The general rules of thumb used to generate these were (in no order):

- 1) Distribution among the entire NERR project area;
- 2) All/some of the site is DEEP property or property in an otherwise protected state (e.g., components could include local land trust/conservation group parcels); and
- 3) In or around the site, meaningful information exists (or there is reason to believe it exists) to enable the review process to begin.

This should be considered fluid - there may be areas that can be removed from consideration (if it is not worth investing effort in any type of evaluation); there may be areas to add that were missed; or there may be areas best considered jointly rather than individually. The goal is to provide a more or less reasonable yet comprehensive inventory to use for beginning the site selection process that can then evolve.
