The Use of the Individual SIR in the CT-WAP Program

The purpose of this guidance is to help clarify how SIR may be used to allow for measures in NEAT, MHEA Audit Tools. This guidance pertains to all CT WAP weatherization programs.

Discontinuation of the Overall SIR

During a DOE monitoring visit, Connecticut was informed that it was not in compliance with 10CFR Part 440 which states that only measures with an individual SIR of one or more can be installed, regardless of the overall SIR (OSIR).

Therefore only the measures that achieve an **INDIVIDUAL SIR** of 1 or more may be installed.

Failure to abide by this policy and the continuation of installing measures that do **NOT** achieve an individual SIR of 1 or more but achieve an overall SIR of 1 or more <u>will result in disallowed</u> <u>cost.</u>

Please note, the <u>only</u> exceptions to this policy are those measures that are allowable under Health and Safety, Leveraged Heating Systems or paid out 100% by HES-IE.
