

From the East: Take I-95 South to exit 39A. Stay straight to go onto Cherry Street. Turn left onto Gulf Street. Follow Gulf Street and Gulf Beach will be on your right.

From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 37 which is the High Street exit. Turn right onto High Street. Turn left onto South Borad Street/Route 162 East Continue to follow Route 162 East. Turn right onto Gulf Street. Follow Gulf Street and Gulf Beach will be on your right.
