

From the East: Take I-95 South to exit 70. Turn left onto Lyme Street. Turn right onto Halls Road, follow for 0.6 miles. Turn left onto Route 156/ Neck Road. Make a right onto Ferry Road. Follow Ferry Road to the end to the DEP Marine Headquarters-Ferry Landing Park.

From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 70. Turn right onto Route 156/Neck Road, follow for 0.3 miles. Turn right onto Ferry Road. Follow Ferry Road to the end to the DEP Marine Headquarters-Ferry Landing Park.
