IN YOUR HOTEL ROOM


- Turn off your lights, television, and air conditioner when not needed.

Section 3: Housekeeping

Use cleaners and detergents that are readily biodegradable and do not contain certain chemicals. Some of the chemicals to avoid that are commonly used are listed below. However, this list is not the complete list and awarding of points is subject to the Pollution Prevention Manager:

- chlorine bleach
- phosphates
