

#### Why Recordkeeping?

- Compliance reasons
- Senior leadership

- Identifies areas of concern to focus on
- Allows the organization to benchmark



#### What are We Tracking?

- Overall Recycling Rate
- Recycling rates- Recycled materials vs. non-recycled
  - Solid waste
  - Medical waste
  - Single Stream (mixed paper, bottles and cans, etc...)
  - Universal waste (batteries, ballasts, electronics, bulbs)
  - RCRA waste (Pharmaceuticals)
  - Grease
  - Scrap metal
  - Office / Medical equipment



#### Environmental Management


- Going above and beyond compliance.

#### **CT Children's Recycling Rate**



#### **CCMC** Recycling

- Increased overall recycling rate from 19.33% in 2007 to 23.34% in 2008
- Goal is 25%
- YTD 2009 is 27.25%
- Paper increased from 35 tons in 2007 to 52 tons in 2008 (33% increase)
- Bottles and cans increased by 2.5 times!
