Hazardous Waste Manifests

- CT DEP receives 100,000 (+) manifest forms each year
 - Hazardous & Non-Hazardous wastes
 - In-state & out-of-state generators
- ~70,000 are entered into our database each year (2007 data).
- Manifest data is a key source for Phase One Site Investigations.
 - Property Transfer Act filings.

Hazardous Waste Manifests

Streamlining the Process

Largest Connecticut TSDFs (2007 data)

- By number of manifests received:
 - Clean Harbors ~22%
 - United & Bridgeport United ~15%
 - Safety Kleen ~ 6%

Total: ~43%

* Excludes CESQGs

Hazardous Waste Manifests

- DEP working to make data more available.
 - 1980's → Annual printed reports available at DEP.
 - 1990's → CD-ROMs (single year each) available for sale.
 - 2000 → Database on public access PC's in DEP fileroom.
 - 2010 → Pilot program makes entire database available for download on FTP site. Includes search routine.

Biennial Hazardous Waste Report

- 440 companies on DEP list for 2009 calendar year.
 - LQGs including smaller generators that tripped LQG thresholds for one or more months in 2009 (Episodic generation event).
 - TSDFs including any facility which ever notified DEP/EPA that they “Stored” or “Treated” hazardous waste and have not gone through “Closure” (Includes interim status facilities).

Biennial Reports

- 2009 calendar year reports due March 1, 2010
- If you receive packet → response required
- Electronic recommended
- *Waste Reporter* – free software
 - Can import previous data
 - Error checking built in
 - Print out completed report
 - Create submission file



2009 Reporting Year

- 1. Import From WMS**
(Optional, not required)
- 2. Direct Form Entry**
- 3. Validate Data**
- 4. Print Forms**
- 5. Create Submission Files**
