▪ **Presentation: Legislative Program Review and Investigations Committee (“LPRI”): *Consideration of Findings and Recommendations – Municipal Solid Waste Management Services in Connecticut.***

In October 2009, LPRI made their presentation on their Report entitled *Municipal Solid Waste Management Services in Connecticut*. It described the characteristics of key elements of the municipal solid waste (MSW) system including collection, recycling, transfer stations, resources recovery facilities, landfills, and out-of-state disposal. It outlined how municipalities operate with respect to each element; identified significant laws and regulations pertinent to each element; provided trends in solid waste management, the planning process, and the roles of various participants in the system; and discussed potential uses of ash residue. Link to this October 2009 Report: http://www.cga.ct.gov/pri/2009_MSWMSC.asp This mid-January (2010), LPRI is expected to present its *Consideration of Findings and Recommendations* to the Legislative Program Review and Investigations Committee. In the formulation of its findings and recommendations, the Program Review Staff considered the following three key questions: “Is the overall municipal solid waste system adequate?”, “Are the solid waste management services provided in Connecticut sustainable as currently structured?” and “Are municipal solid waste services available at a reasonable cost?”.
