SWAC E-Waste Update

- Recent Approval of 7 CERs – [List of Approved CERs](http://www.ct.gov/deep/lib/deep/e-waste/approvedcers.pdf)

 - Two year approval
 - 3 Withdrawn, 3 Rejected (two previous CERs)

What should municipalities / regions do if need to change a CER?

- Existing CER approval extended
- Transition to new CER before to April 5

Preliminary E-waste program data***:

Amount Recycled

- 9,673,941 pounds (2.7 lbs/ capita)

- February 2011 – February 2012

Program savings to municipalities***

2010 - \$280K

2011 - \$270K

***64% towns reported to DEEP


