- Recycler Open Application Period – ends February 7th
- Anticipated Changes to [List of Approved CERs](#)
- What should municipalities / regions do if need to change a CER?
  - Existing CER approval extended
  - Transition to new CER
- Existing recyclers must submit proposed fees by deadline.


