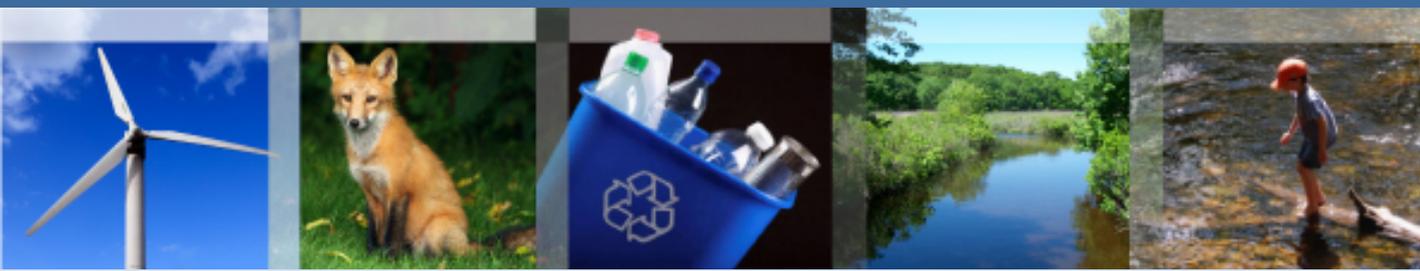

Urban Mining CT, LLC

- Beneficial Use Determination (BUD) Approval for the beneficial use of a solid waste in the manufacturing process.
- BUD issued to Urban Mining CT, LLC for use of Glass at site in Beacon Falls, CT.
- Prior Authorization for Site in Monroe, CT.
- Glass to be used primarily as Pozzolan in concrete.
- Other uses: Industrial filler in paints, coatings, adhesives, sealants, inks, polymers, plastics.
- Glass to be sourced from CT facilities and surrounding regional facilities.
- Plant Capacity: 31,000 TPY
