Fred Andes mentioned Illinois reports on TN and TP treatment that he would share.

The questionnaire was discussed. We are looking to get data to be able to graph \$/lb TP removed vs flow?

What does Cytec have for a TP limit?

Can we get WPCF data from the Chesapeake region state DEPs? WERF?

Can we get USGS TP data from the Quinnipiac from this past season since all POTWs were at 0.7 mg/l TP? Rowland will check on it.

Who's going to do analysis of the reports? Rowland will check on this.

Fred Andes asked about the possibility of dam removals and their cost implications. Dennis Waz mentioned the Carpenter Dam and another in Southington and wondered how their removal would impact limits.

Rowland will check on monies to put our report together. Can we add compilation to CASE scope?
