SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS OF RICHARD J. WEISBERG


My name is Richard J. Weisberg. I reside at 34 Prince's Pine Road, Norwalk, CT 06850. I submit the comments below to supplement the written comments I previously submitted to the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection at its public hearing on February 3, 2010, in response to its Notice soliciting comments to its Proposed Revisions To Connecticut Water Quality Standards, dated December 22, 2009 (the "Proposed Revisions").

I did not make the following comment at the February 3 hearing, since being allotted only 3 minutes of time tended to preclude this, and it relates to a matter of form, which is difficult to describe in writing. I will try below.

In Appendix E of the Proposed Revisions, I noted that its organizational format, i.e., the designations of the sections, sub-sections, and sub-sub-sections, etc, were not standardized. Indeed, Appendix E looked like it had been prepared by 3 or 4 different individuals, each of whom had his or her own designation system. For example, in the second section of Appendix E, the designations are as follows: section (Roman numerals – upper case); sub-sections (Arabic numerals); sub-sub-sections (alphabetical – uppercase). In the fifth section of the designations are as follows: section (Roman numerals – upper case); sub-sections (no designation, or Arabic numerals, or alphabetized – upper case); sub-sub-sections (alphabetized – lower case, or roman numerals – lower case). This is somewhat confusing to the reader, and I would think that the Department would want to standardize its organizational format throughout its WQS.
