- -In the eligible activities section, surface water has been struck. Does this mean that site developments that will be able to re-infiltrate storm water and dewatering water to ground water are also required to get this permit?
- -Is a solar array project that has been completed and has point source storm water discharges to surface waters considered an " industrial activity " that is required to register for the GP for industrial activities? I'm asking this in the context of a ruling some years ago by CTDEEP that exempted hydro-electric facilities from registering for IND storm water GP.
