

Import permits are required to import and possess any wild animal that is listed:

- Endangered, threatened, or species of special concern; OR
- Under Section 26-55-6(a)(4)(B) of the Connecticut General Statutes

It is no longer necessary to apply for an importation permit through the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection for pigeons, pheasant, quail, chukars, or mallards. Please contact the Department of Agriculture at (860) 713-2505 or (860) 713-2508 for an importation permit or bird permit.
