<p>Recovery Friendly Communities Guidelines</p>	<p>We continued to discuss the concept of Recovery Friendly Communities and reviewed the next draft of the “rubric”/guidelines that evolved from previous discussions, the Community Recovery Capital Assessment and the document that Jody created based on November’s discussion. Another great discussion about how this document will be vetted and eventually distributed.
