Please find below important new information regarding DDaP implementation:

-  **1. New Features in DDaP Release 1.6 -**
 - **Client Search** - An Advanced Search option was added. This allows a search to be done using First Name and/or Last Name and/or DOB.
 - **CONFIRM CANCEL prompt** - Added to all screens in the admission wizard and discharge wizard. Also added to the edit mode of the client info in the Admission Wizard.
 - **Jail Diversion Assessment** - Added new textbox, labeled "Name of Evaluating Clinician".
 - **Criminal Charges** - Additional charges have been added to the JD assessment and some charge types (Felony vs. Misdemeanor) that were incorrect have been changed.
