Update Active Consumer's Insurance Type

It has come to the attention of DMHAS EQMI that some provider's active consumers have old outdated insurance types (ie: General Assistance). This information needs to be updated on a regular basis depending on the consumer's insurance type changes that may occur periodically.

To that end, please be sure that all active consumers within your agency have updated insurance information in the WITs (State-operated facilities) and DDaP (DMHAS funded Private not for Profit Agencies) data systems.

This information is important when determining accurate aggregate insurance types and cost projections regarding consumers receiving services within the DMHAS system of care.
