Please be aware that the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services has added one new question to the DMHAS Critical Incident Reporting Form.

Specifically, the new question is as follows:

“Is there evidence that this incident involves domestic/relationship violence”?

The following is the definition of Domestic/Relationship Violence:

Domestic violence (also referred to as Intimate Partner Violence or IPV) can be physical, sexual, emotional, economic, or psychological actions or threats of actions against a partner. This includes any behaviors that intimidate, manipulate, humiliate, isolate, frighten, terrorize, coerce, threaten, blame, hurt, injure, or wound a partner.
