These data management strategies are designed to ensure that the quality reports are returning the best performance data for providers and for statewide averages. It is very important that providers pay close attention to these data quality issues and make corrections and or updates when necessary. DSM 5/GAF – ICD 10: Any provider wishing to convert to the DSM 5 should contact Mark for extract testing purposes. The GAF reporting requirement will continue under the DSM 5 reporting processes. ICD 10 reporting is scheduled to be implemented in October 2015.
