- 1751-** James Madison, 4th US President born on this day.
- 1802-** Frist US Military Academy at West Point is established through Congressional act (opened July 4, 1802)
- 1829-** Ohio authorizes high school night classes.
- 1830-** New York Stock Exchange slowest day ever (31 shares traded)
- 1850-** Nathaniel Hawthorne’s “The Scarlet Letter” published in Boston.
- 1882-** US Senate ratifies treaty establishing the Red Cross.
- 1912-** Mrs. William Howard Taft plants the 1st cherry tree in Washington, D.C.
- 1926-** Jerry Lewis, American comedian, born on this day.

How to Properly Perform Hand Hygiene
