Logging in

Enter your CT-Registration number assigned by DRS in the space provided ending in **000** or **001** then **press the login button.**

IMPORTANT: Effective July 1, 2011 Conn. Gen. Stat. § 12-408(1) Connecticut increased the general sales tax rate and added new ones as follows:

- 6.35% on the general sales tax rate
- 7.00% on sales and purchases subject to luxury tax made on or after July 1, 2011
- 9.35% on rental of passenger vehicles up to 30 consecutive days

The TSC has been updated to reflect these changes by clicking on the appropriate tax rate button(s) after logging in as usual.

You will need your Connecticut Tax Registration Number (CT REG) to log into the Connecticut Taxpayer Service Center.

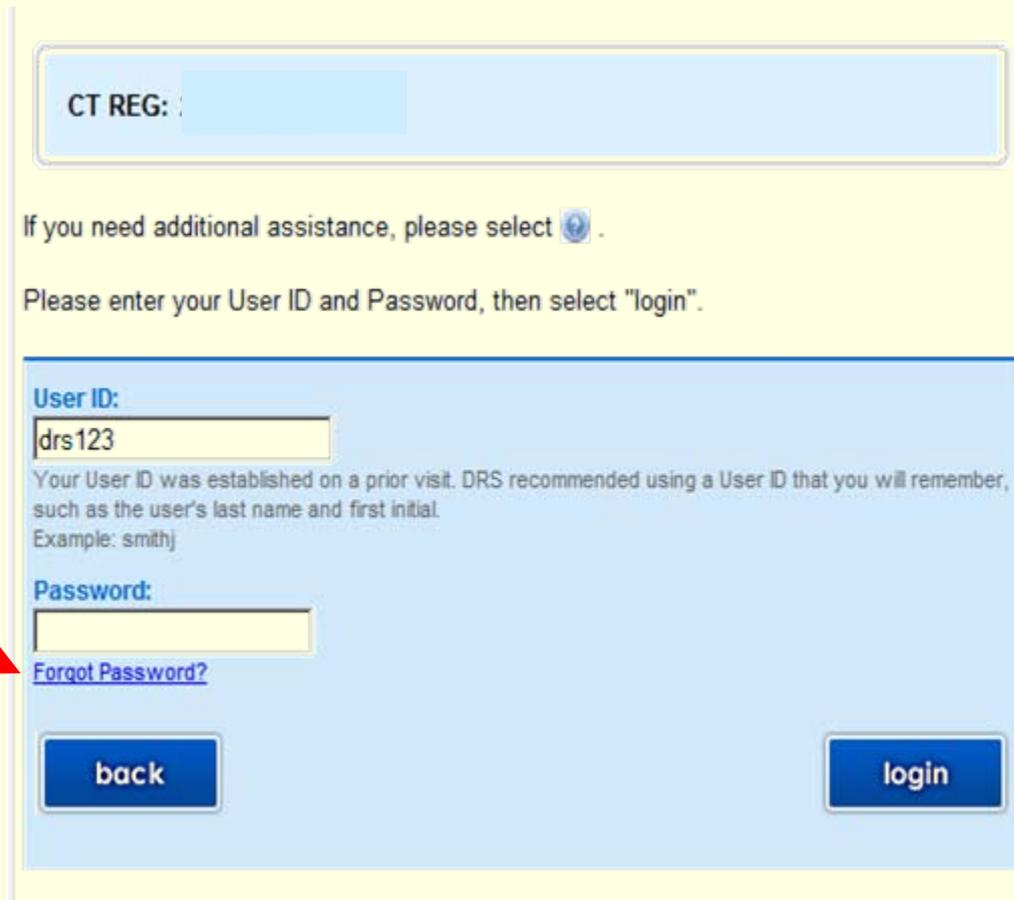
