Raised Bill 248
An Act Concerning Access to Identity Documents by
Homeless Youth and Young Adults

Committee on Public Health - March 6, 2020

The Office of Chief Public Defender supports Raised Bill 248 – An Act Concerning Access to Identity Documents by Homeless Youth and Young Adults. This proposal will allow homeless young people to get access to their birth certificate free of charge. Homeless youth confront many barriers as they emerge in to adulthood. Certified birth certificates are often required in order to enroll in post high school education programs or apply for jobs. Young people, particularly those experiencing homelessness will not have easy access to these documents. Our staff regularly assists clients obtain identity documents to enter treatment programs or obtain other needed support services. Removing the barrier the fee requirement imposes on these young people is a good step forward to helping them become successful adults. The Office of Chief Public Defender respectfully urges this Committee to act favorably on this proposal.
