Dear Comptroller Lembo:

The following information on the state's General Fund for fiscal year 2015 is provided in accordance with Section 4-66 of the General Statutes. In addition, an analysis of the Special Transportation Fund is included due to the significant nature of this fund. In compliance with Executive Order No. 1, issued January 5, 2011, these projections reflect the state's estimated year-end balance in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).

General Fund

The adopted budget anticipates a \$0.3 million balance from operations. At this time we project that both revenues and expenditures will be consistent with the budget plan. Better than anticipated revenue performance at the close of fiscal year 2014, particularly in the withholding component of the Personal Income Tax, is a positive sign as we enter fiscal year 2015. Note, however, that we are closely monitoring federal review of Medicaid reimbursements for a variety of programs and services provided by the departments of Social Services, Developmental Services and Mental Health and Addiction Services. OPM and the agencies are actively engaged with the federal government in addressing issues relating to claiming methodologies and allowable costs, and we anticipate resolution before the fiscal year ends.

Special Transportation Fund

Estimated revenues and expenditures remain unchanged relative to the adopted budget. We anticipate the fund balance on June 30, 2015 to be \$175.5 million.

It is important to note that this represents the first projection of the state's General Fund and Special Transportation Fund positions for FY 2015. As the year progresses, these estimates will be adjusted to reflect the impact of changes in the economy, expenditure patterns, and/or other factors.
