Dear Senator Fasano-

I apologize for the delay in responding to your recent request relating to OPM and OFA's 01-15-2014 Consensus Revenue Estimates. As you know, at this time of the year, our budget and legal staff are stretched extremely thin on a variety of legislative, budgetary and other matters.

Given the importance of the consensus revenue process in providing reliable revenue projections for both the executive and legislative branches, I have given this matter considerable attention before responding to you. We have reviewed our records and discussed our recollections of the process. Based on that, I am providing to you here documents laying out OPM's revenue projections from Monday afternoon, January 13, and then on Wednesday afternoon, the day that the consensus was achieved. I believe these records are responsive to your request.

I would note that our internal discussions about revenue forecasts rely on multiple staff members, our collective efforts to understand the state and national economies, various data sources from inside and outside of state government, discussions with economists and business people, and any other source of insight we can identify. I know that OFA is similarly thoughtful in their approach. While I was initially concerned that providing you this information would have a chilling effect on the effective consensus process we have in place, I have ultimately come to the view that the opposite is true. I believe that full disclosure of our process for coming to consensus with OFA will strengthen the confidence that your colleagues in the legislature — and the public — have in this critical undertaking.

Thank you for your patience in this matter.

Dear Secretary Barnes:

As you are aware, section 2-36c of the Connecticut General Statutes requires the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) and the Director of the Office of Fiscal Analysis (OFA) to jointly issue consensus revenue estimates not later than November tenth annually, January fifteenth annually and April thirtieth annually.

In the preparation of these estimates, it is my understanding that it is common practice for your office to prepare initial revenue estimates for each of the state's revenue streams and share such estimates with OFA for review prior to any substantive negotiations. Similarly, I assume that OFA shares its preliminary estimates with your office. Please accept this letter as a formal request to your agency for copies of any and all revenue estimates supplied by you to OFA as well as copies of any revenue estimates received by you from OFA.

In addition, I would like all records relating to the development of the January 15, 2014 consensus revenue estimates, including but not limited to correspondence between anyone in OPM and OFA and/or the Comptroller's Office. Such records may include, but not be limited to, e-mails, letters, notes, text messages, faxes, etc.

I anticipate that this request will not be difficult to produce and will be fulfilled expeditiously. If you could please call my office when it is complete, I will send someone to come pick it up from your office or if you prefer to scan and email it to me, that would be appreciated. If you need me to submit this request pursuant to the Freedom of Information, I would be more than happy to do so just call me on my cell phone at (203) 640-4176 and let me know.
