No funds derived from the sale of bonds authorized by this Commission without a finding that the reports and statements required hereby have been filed with it shall be allotted by the Governor for any project until the reports and statements required hereby with respect to such project, have been filed with the Secretary of this Commission.

DOES HEREBY DIRECT THAT all federal, private and other moneys now available or hereafter to be made available for costs in connection with the projects described and identified in said request of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management or his designee shall be added to the State moneys available or becoming available under said Act for such projects and be used for such projects as if constituting such State moneys; and

DOES HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. Special Tax Obligation Bonds of the State of Connecticut are hereby authorized to be issued in the amount of \$10,000,000 in order to provide funds for the purposes and projects described in the request of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management or his designee entitled "Request No. 5 To The State Bond Commission Pursuant To Sections 39-44 of Public Act No. 13-239 of the January, 2013 Regular Session Of The General Assembly Of The State Of Connecticut, As Amended, For Authorization of \$10,000,000 Special Tax Obligation Bonds Of The State", dated February 28, 2014, and said Request is hereby approved and ordered to be filed with the records of this meeting.

The aggregate amount of Special Tax Obligation Bonds authorized to date under the Act, including the \$10,000,000 authorized by this resolution, is \$612,610,724, of which amount no bonds have previously been issued.

Section 2. The form, date, maturities and other details of such authorized but unissued bonds shall be hereafter determined by this Commission or by the State Treasurer acting in accordance with procedures to be established by this Commission.

Section 3. The Secretary or his designee is authorized to accept on behalf of this Commission, the reports and statements required to be filed by the Act.

PUBLIC ACT NO. 13-239 OF THE JANUARY 2013 SESSION

Under Public Act No. 13-239 of the January 2013 Session (the "Act") there was filed with the Commission a request signed by the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, dated February 28, 2014, entitled: "Request No. 1 to the State Bond Commission Pursuant to Public Act No. 13-239 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, January 2013 Session, as amended, for Approval of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, for Authorization of \$200,000,000 plus costs of issuance and capitalized interest, if any, Bonds of the State and for Approval of the Form of the Memorandum of Understanding Under Public Act No. 13-239 of the January 2013 Session", which request is set forth in Exhibit A (the "Request") and hereby made a part hereof and which is in form and substance as required by the State Bond Commission and law for a request for approval of the form of such master indenture pursuant to the Act.

The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management or his designees then proceeded to explain and discuss with the Commission the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, the issuance of bonds to finance costs of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund and the form of the Memorandum of Understanding pursuant to the Act.

Thereupon there was submitted to the Commission, in writing, a proposed form of a resolution to approve the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, to authorize the issuance of bonds referred to in the request and to approve the form of Memorandum of Understanding, entitled "Resolution of the State Bond Commission Authorizing the Issuance of Bonds of the State in Principal Amounts Not Exceeding in the Aggregate \$200,000,000 plus costs of issuance and capitalized interest, if any, to Finance Costs of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, and Approving the Memorandum of Understanding Providing for the Issuance of Said Bonds, Dated As Of February 28, 2014, Between the Board of Directors of Connecticut Innovations, Incorporated and the State of Connecticut, Acting By and Through the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management and the State Treasurer Pursuant to Sections 70 to 73 of Public Act 13-239 of the January 2013 Session".

After review and discussion of the documents so filed and submitted and upon motion duly made, seconded and carried by unanimous vote, the Commission adopted the resolution as follows:

RESOLUTION OF THE STATE BOND COMMISSION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE STATE IN PRINCIPAL AMOUNTS NOT EXCEEDING IN THE AGGREGATE \$200,000,000 PLUS COSTS OF ISSUANCE AND CAPITALIZED INTEREST, IF ANY, TO FINANCE COSTS OF THE CONNECTICUT BIOSCIENCE INNOVATION FUND, AND APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SAID BONDS, DATED AS OF FEBRUARY 28, 2014, BETWEEN THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CONNECTICUT INNOVATIONS, INCORPORATED AND THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE SECRETARY OF THE OFFICE OF POLICY AND MANAGEMENT AND THE STATE TREASURER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 70 TO 73 OF PUBLIC ACT 13-239 OF THE JANUARY 2013 SESSION.

The State Bond Commission of the State of Connecticut existing under and by virtue of Section 3-20 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, and consisting of the Governor, the Treasurer, the Comptroller, the Attorney General, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, the Commissioner of the Department of Administrative Services, the Co-chairpersons and ranking minority members of the Committee on Finance, Revenue and Bonding of the General Assembly of the State;

DOES HEREBY FIND THAT there has been filed with the State Bond Commission a request signed by or on behalf of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management (the "State") for the approval of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, the authorization of bonds to finance the costs of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund and the form of the Memorandum of Understanding in accordance with the Act, and entitled "Request No. 1 to the State Bond Commission Pursuant to Public Act No. 13-239 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, January 2013 Session, as amended, for Approval of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, for Authorization of \$200,000,000 plus costs of issuance and capitalized

interest, if any, Bonds of the State and for Approval of the Form of the Memorandum of Understanding Under Public Act No. 13-239 of the January 2013 Session”; and

THAT said request states all such terms and conditions as the State Bond Commission requires and is in all other respects a sufficient request for such authorization pursuant to the Act; and

THAT, pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding, there has been filed with the State Bond Commission statements, requests and all other documents required by subparagraphs (A), (B), (C), (D) and (E) of subdivision 1 of subsection (g) of Section 3-20 of the General Statutes of Connecticut or by the State Bond Commission and any advisory statement regarding the State Conservation and Development Policies Plan required by Section 16a-31 of the General Statutes; and THAT the authorization of such bonds will be in the best interests of the State; and

THAT there has been filed with the State Bond Commission all other documents required by the Act; and

THAT the adoption of this resolution is necessary to carry out the purposes enunciated in the Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BY THIS RESOLUTION DOES HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. This Resolution of the State Bond Commission is adopted pursuant to the Act and Section 3-20 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 72 of the Act, the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, comprised of projects and provisions set forth in the Act is hereby approved.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 73(a) of the Act, the issuance of bonds of the State in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate \$200,000,000 plus costs of issuance and capitalized interest, if any, and capped in each fiscal year as provided in the Act, to the extent the board of directors of Connecticut Innovations, Incorporated does not provide for the use of all or a portion of such amount in a fiscal year, and provided further, the costs of the issuance and capitalized interest, if any, may be added to the capped amount in each fiscal year is hereby authorized.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 73(b) of the Act, the form of the Memorandum of Understanding, dated as of February 28, 2014, by and between the board of directors of Connecticut Innovations, Incorporated and the State, acting by and through the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management and the Treasurer, attached hereby as Attachment I, is hereby approved.

Section 5. This resolution shall be effective immediately as and for a resolution of the State Bond Commission pursuant to and in conformity with law, and the original of this resolution shall be made a part of the records for this meeting.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
PROVIDING FOR
THE FUNDING OF
THE CONNECTICUT BIOSCIENCE INNOVATION FUND**

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING PROVIDING FOR THE FUNDING OF THE CONNECTICUT BIOSCIENCE INNOVATION FUND** (this "MOU") is dated as of February 20, 2014, between and among Connecticut Innovations, Incorporated, in its capacity as administrator of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund (the "Administrator"), the State of Connecticut (the "State") acting by and through the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management (the "Secretary") and the State Treasurer (the "Treasurer"):

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Sections 70 to 73, inclusive of Public Act 13-239 of the 2013 Regular Session of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut (said sections being hereinafter sometimes referred to together as the "Act"), (i) establish the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation fund (the "Fund"), to be held, administered, invested and disbursed by Connecticut Innovations, Incorporated, acting as administrator of the Fund (the "Administrator"), (ii) create the Bioscience Innovation Advisory Committee (the "Advisory Committee") to approve expenditures from the Fund for purposes of financial assistance to eligible recipients pursuant to the Act; and (iii) authorize the issuance of bonds of the State to fund the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 73(a) of Public Act 13-239 provides that the State Bond Commission shall authorize the issuance of bonds of the State in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000) for the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, and that the amount authorized for issuance and sale shall be capped in each fiscal year at amounts set forth in such section with each such authorization effective as of July 1 of such fiscal year, provided, to the extent the Advisory Committee does not provide for the use of all or a portion of such amount in a fiscal year, such amount not provided for shall be carried forward and added to the authorized amount for the next succeeding fiscal year, and provided further, the costs of issuance and capitalized interest, if any, may be added to the capped amount in each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Section 73(b) of Public Act 13-239 provides that the State Bond Commission shall approve a memorandum of understanding between and among the Administrator, the State, acting by and through the Secretary and the Treasurer, providing for the issuance of such bonds for the purposes of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund, including provisions regarding the extent to which federal, private or other moneys then available or thereafter to be made available for costs should be added to the proceeds of the bonds authorized pursuant to such section for such project or program, and that the

memorandum of understanding shall be deemed to satisfy the provisions of section 3-20 of the general statutes and the exercise of any right or power granted thereby which is not inconsistent with the provisions of such section; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator, the State, acting by and through the Secretary, and the Treasurer desire to enter into this MOU to provide for the issuance of such bonds pursuant to the Act and as provided for pursuant to this MOU.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual agreements herein contained, the Administrator, the State, acting by and through the Secretary and the Treasurer agree as follows:

SECTION 1. Application of State General Obligation Bond Procedure Act.

Unless specifically provided otherwise in this MOU, the provisions of Section 3-20 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Revision of 1958 (the State General Obligation Bond Procedure Act) are adopted for the purposes of the sale, issuance and delivery of the State's general obligation bonds to fund the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund.

SECTION 2. Bond Authorization. (a) Upon the approval by the State Bond Commission of (i) a resolution authorizing the issuance of bonds of the State in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000) as provided by Section 73(a) of Public Act 13-239, and (ii) this MOU as provided by Section 73(b) of Public Act 13-239, no further approval by the State Bond Commission shall be required for the authorization, issuance and allocation of bonds for the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund.

(b) Subject only to the capping provisions of Section 73(a) of Public Act 13-239, including the addition, if any, of costs of issuance and capitalized interest to the capped amount, issuance of the bonds authorized thereunder shall be deemed to have been requested and approved for purposes of the Act and the principal amount of the bonds so authorized shall be deemed to be an appropriation and allocation of such amount, and such approval shall be deemed the allotment by the Governor of such capital outlays within the meaning of Section 4-85 of the Connecticut General Statutes. Amounts may be expended (and if previously advanced by the Administrator for a proper purpose pursuant to the Act, reimbursed to the Administrator), and contracts may be awarded and obligations incurred by the Administrator pursuant to the Act in amounts not in the aggregate exceeding such authorized principal amount, notwithstanding that such expenditures, contracts and obligations may at any particular time exceed the amount of the proceeds from the sale of such bonds theretofore received by the State and made available to the Administrator for the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund.

(c) The Administrator shall provide to the Governor, the Secretary and the Treasurer a copy of each annual report of the activities of the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund as and when submitted to the legislative committees of cognizance pursuant to Section 72(k) of Public Act 13-239.

(d) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in subsection (b) of this

Section 2, the Administrator may issue commitments for financial assistance from the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund approved by the Advisory Committee, encumbering and to be funded from the proceeds of bonds authorized for issuance by the Act in the same fiscal year or in a fiscal year subsequent to the fiscal year in which such commitment is issued, provided that the total of all such commitments and other obligations or expenses encumbering and payable from the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund in any particular fiscal year shall not exceed the amount of bonds authorized for issuance by the Act in such fiscal year, including any unused amount carried forward and added to the authorized amount in such fiscal year pursuant to Section 73(a) of the Act.

(e) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (a) and (b) of this Section 2, no bonds shall be approved until the statements, requests and other documents required by subparagraphs (A), (B), (C), (D) and (E) of subdivision (1) of subsection (g) of the Bond Procedure Act are filed with the Secretary. The Secretary shall notify the Administrator and the Treasurer at such time as this requirement shall have been met.

SECTION 3. Bond Issuance. (a) Subject only to the capping provisions of Section 73(a) of Public Act 13-239, including the addition, if any, of costs of issuance and capitalized interest, the Treasurer may issue one or more series of bonds for the purpose of funding the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund as may be determined by the Treasurer to be in the best interest of the State and as provided in the resolution of the State Bond Commission authorizing the issuance of bonds of the State and this MOU. The Treasurer may pay any expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of such bonds, including the issuance of any refunding bonds, from the accrued interest and premiums or from the proceeds of the sale of such bonds or refunding bonds and in the same manner as other general obligations of the State.

(b) The Treasurer shall maintain a general obligation bond fund for the purpose of accounting for the authorization and issuance of bonds pursuant to Section 73(a) of Public Act 13-239. Transfers from the bond fund to the Administrator for the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund can be made as authorized without regard to the balance in such bond fund and the Treasurer may issue bonds to fund such transfers in advance or in arrears in accordance with the procedures followed for other general obligation bond proceeds.

(c) Pursuant to and in accordance with Section 73(b) of Public Act 13-239 and subsection (y) of the State General Obligation Bond Procedure Act, this MOU constitutes a recommendation and authorization that all federal, private or other money now available or hereafter to be made available for costs of any project or program eligible for financial assistance from the Connecticut Bioscience Innovation Fund be added to the proceeds of the bonds authorized pursuant to Section 73(a) of Public Act 13-239 for purposes of such project or program.

SECTION 4. Tax Compliance. (a) The Administrator agrees that Connecticut Innovations, Inc. ("CII") shall submit such information, and perform such actions, including recordkeeping, loan tracking and expenditure tracking, as shall be reasonably

requested by the Treasurer to establish a basis for the bonds issued pursuant to Section 2 to be issued on such basis as the interest thereon shall be free from Federal income taxation in the hands of the holders of such bonds. Upon the request of the Treasurer, CII shall certify this undertaking for the purpose of issuance of such bonds.

(b) The Treasurer may, if the Treasurer determines it is necessary or desirable, from time to time hold a public hearing for purposes of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and submit the issuance of bonds for the approval of the Governor. The Administrator agrees to cause CII to submit such information as the Treasurer may reasonably require for such purposes.

(c) The Administrator agrees that CII shall obtain the agreement of any recipient of proceeds of the bonds, whether in the form of a grant or a loan, to terms and conditions that will allow such bonds to be issued on such basis as the interest thereon shall be free from Federal income taxation in the hands of the holders of such bonds. The Treasurer shall identify for CII those terms and conditions in effect from time to time, which may include but not be limited to limitations on private business use, management contracts and research contracts. CII shall obtain the agreement of any such recipient to follow prescribed actions as may be required to remedy any failure to conform to such terms and conditions.

SECTION 5. State Bond Commission Approval. The effectiveness of this MOU is expressly conditioned on its approval by the State Bond Commission, and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall be of no effect until such approval has been obtained. If the State Bond Commission has not approved this MOU and the issuance of the bonds by February 28, 2014, this MOU may be terminated by any party thereto without obligation.





Under Section 21(b)(6)(B) of Public Act 79-607 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, as amended (the "Act"), there was filed with the Commission one or more requests, signed by or on behalf of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management or by or on behalf of an officer, department or agency referred to in the Act, dated February 28, 2014 and entitled: "Request Nos. 1200, 1201, 1202 and 1203 to the State Bond Commission Pursuant to Section 21(a) of Public Act 79-607 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, as amended, for Authorization of \$930,000 Bonds of the State under Section 21(a) of said Act", in form and substance as required by law for authorization of bonds for the purposes described in Section 21(b)(6)(B) of the Act.

Thereupon there was submitted to the Commission, in writing, a proposed form of a resolution to authorize pursuant to Public Act 79-607 the issuance of the bonds referred to in the requests and entitled "Resolution of the State Bond Commission Authorizing \$930,000 Bonds of the State of Connecticut Pursuant to Public Act No. 79-607 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, as amended."

After review and discussion of the documents so filed and submitted and upon motion duly made, seconded and carried by unanimous vote, the Commission adopted the resolution as follows:

RESOLUTION OF THE STATE BOND COMMISSION AUTHORIZING \$930,000 BONDS OF THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT PURSUANT TO PUBLIC ACT NO. 79-607 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT, AS AMENDED

The State Bond Commission of the State of Connecticut, existing under and by virtue of Section 3-20 of the General Statutes of Connecticut and consisting of the Governor, the Treasurer, the Comptroller, the Attorney General, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, the Commissioner of the Department of Administrative Services, the Co-chairpersons and the ranking minority members of the Committee on Finance, Revenue and Bonding of the General Assembly, of the State,

DOES HEREBY FIND THAT there has been filed with the State Bond Commission one or more requests by or on behalf of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management of the State of Connecticut for the authorization of the bonds hereinafter mentioned, dated February 28, 2014 and entitled "Request Nos. 1200, 1201, 1202 and 1203 to the State Bond Commission Pursuant to Section 21(a) of Public Act No. 79-607 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, as amended, for Authorization of \$930,000 Bonds of the State under Section 21(a) of said Act";

THAT said requests are signed by or on behalf of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management or by or on behalf of an officer, department, or agency referred to in the Act, and all such terms and conditions as the State Bond Commission requires are stated therein and the request or requests are in all other respects sufficient for authorization of bonds of the State under or pursuant to Section 21(b)(6)(B) of Public Act No. 79-607 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, as amended;

THAT, there has been filed with the State Bond Commission all other documents required by subsection (g) of Section 3-20 of the General Statutes of Connecticut or by the State Bond Commission, including any human services facility colocation statement to be filed with the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, if so requested by the Secretary, pursuant to Section 4b-23, as amended, of the General Statutes, any statement from the Commissioner of Agriculture pursuant to Section 22-6 of the General Statutes for projects which would convert twenty-five acres or more of prime farmland to a non-agricultural use, any capital development impact statement required to be filed with the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, if so required by the Secretary, pursuant to Section 4b-23, as amended, of the General Statutes, a statement as to the full cost of the project or purpose when completed and the estimated operating cost for any structure, equipment or facility to be constructed or acquired, and any

advisory statement regarding the State Conservation and Development Policies Plan required by Section 16a-31 of the General Statutes; and THAT the authorization of such bonds will be in the best interests of the State; and

DOES HEREBY DIRECT THAT all federal, private and other moneys now available or hereafter to be made available for costs in connection with the project described and identified in said request by or on behalf of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall be added to the State moneys available or becoming available under said Act for such project and be used for such project as if constituting such State moneys; and

DOES HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. The amount of Community Conservation Development Bonds authorized to be issued pursuant to Section 21(a) of Public Act No. 79-607 of the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut, as amended, is hereby increased by \$930,000 in order to provide funds for the purposes and projects described in the requests submitted by or on behalf of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management and entitled "Request Nos. 1200, 1201, 1202 and 1203 To The State Bond Commission Pursuant To Section 21(a) Of Public Act 79-607 Of The General Assembly Of The State Of Connecticut, As Amended, For Authorization Of \$930,000 Bonds Of The State", dated February 28, 2014 and hereby approved and ordered to be filed with the records of this meeting.

The aggregate amount of Community Conservation Development Bonds authorized to date pursuant to Section 21(a) of Public Act No. 79-607 and unissued to date, including the \$930,000 authorized by this resolution, is \$154,188,958.84. Bonds in the principal amount of \$1,133,450,876.16 (Series A through Series OO), have previously been issued.

Section 2. The form, date, maturities and other details of such authorized but unissued bonds shall be hereafter determined by this Commission or by the State Treasurer acting in accordance with procedures to be established by this Commission.

RESOLVED, (1) that the requests and certificates and the appropriate resolutions to effect the bond authorizations approved today are hereby approved and adopted; (2) that the resolutions and the State Treasurer's certificate as to state indebtedness made in accordance with section 3-21 of the general statutes, as amended, be made a part of the record of today's meeting; (3) that the State hereby declares the official intent of the State required pursuant to Section 1.150-2 of the Federal Income Tax Regulations, Title 26, and, if applicable, pursuant to section 54A(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, with respect to each of the agenda items approved today, to the effect that the State reasonably expects to reimburse from the proceeds of borrowings, including qualified tax credit bonds, any and all expenditures paid from the bond fund accounts designated and functionally described in each such agenda item or bond authorization resolution, in an amount anticipated not to exceed the amount of the authorization contained in such item or bond authorization resolution, and that the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management and the Treasurer are authorized to amend this declaration of official intent on behalf of the State for any such item; and (4) that the State Treasurer is authorized to make representations and enter into agreements to provide secondary market disclosure information with respect to borrowings by State authorities or other entities, or by the State itself, in connection with which the State may be an obligated party under Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission.
