SUBJECT: Negotiated Agreements and Grievance Stipulations

You are reminded that the Office of Policy and Management, specifically the Office of Labor Relations, is the designated representative for collective bargaining for the following bargaining units.

1. NP-1 State Police	8. NP-9 State Police Lieutenants and Captains
2. NP-2 Maintenance and Service	9. P-1 Professional Health Care
3. NP-3 Administrative and Clerical	10. P-2 Social and Human Services
4. NP-4 Corrections	11. P-3A Education Administrators
5. NP-5 Protective Services	12. P-3B Education Professional
6. NP-6 Para-Professional Health Care	13. P-4 Engineering, Scientific and Technical
7. NP-8 Correctional Supervisors	14. P-5 Administrative and Residual

You are again reminded that once a grievance has been submitted to the Office of Labor Relations any resolution/stipulated agreement <u>must</u> involve the representative of the Office of Labor Relations assigned to the grievance. The OLR Representative will negotiate on behalf of your Agency.

All negotiated agreements entered into with the above bargaining units noted that involve contract interpretation matters <u>must</u> include a signature of a representative of the Office of Labor Relations to be enforceable. For example, agencies cannot enter into enforceable agreements which purport to give reemployment and/or SEBAC rights to employees who do not otherwise qualify for such rights, grant pension credit, etc.
