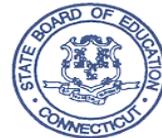

Child Nutrition Database Release 18



The [Child Nutrition Database Release 18 \(CN18\)](#) was made available at the Healthy Meals Resource System Web site on March 26, 2014. Computer software companies with software approved by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for Nutrient Analysis are required to update their software with CN18.

The CN Database is an integral part of the nutrient analysis software approved by the USDA and the USDA expects software companies with USDA-approved software to incorporate CN18 into their products and to make the new version of the software available to current users no later than **July 1, 2014**. Anyone who does not receive an update with the current CN Database by July 1, 2014, should contact his or her software company.

The following chart provides a snapshot of the content of CN18 and a summary of new and updated items. Additionally, CN18 will include total sugars, reported in grams.

All new and updated nutrient information will be included with the next annual springtime release of the CN Database.
