



Next Steps

1. Ensure all data users have a **College Board Education Professional Account**
2. Identify an **Access Manager**, who is responsible for logging into the Manage Access Tool and assigning access roles to additional school staff
3. Have students create **College Board and Khan Academy accounts** with easy-to-remember usernames and passwords
4. Have students download the ***Daily Practice for the New SAT App***
5. Promote consistent **practice** (recommended minimum 30 minutes a day, two times a week) through Khan Academy and Teacher Implementation Guides
