As a recipient of an Immigrant Children and Youth Program Grant for 2013-14, attached is the Request for Proposal 2013-2014. The due date is Friday, November 8, 2013. In the Search box type "RFP" and it will take you to a listing of all RFPs. Please see next page for a list of recipients.

This year's RFP will be judged more closely based on your expressed NEED for the funds and how they will benefit immigrant children. Please heed this closely.

In discussion this summer with the U.S. Department of Education we have received the following clarifications.

- Foreign exchange students or students on a visa count as immigrants if they meet the federal definition of immigrant students.
  - ages 3 through 21 enrolled full-time in elementary and secondary school;
  - not born in any state; and
  - have not been attending one or more schools in any one or more states for more than a total of three full academic years.

Your award is based on your data collection which might encompass students at private schools. The portion of your award based on those students must be spent on their behalf. Any expenditures, including personnel or purchases, must be done by your district. For example, any staff hired must be your employees. Any purchases made must be with your school district Purchase Order system. In addition any educational entity receiving these federal funds must agree to abide by all civil rights laws and must have policies and practice in place, i.e. Title IX.

Any funds declined or any RFP's not approved will have those amounts re-allocated to the other districts entitled to the funds.
